COVID-19, NEW TRAVEL QUARANTINE RULES

We remind you that from March 30th, a revised travel quarantine regulations entered into force.

ARRIVALS FROM SCHENGEN

Passengers arriving at Warsaw Chopin Airport from the Schengen area are exempt from compulsory quarantine **if they also have a negative test result in Polish or English, made within 48 hours before crossing the border** and present the result at the request of a Border Guard officer and in the Hotel during registration. Schengen passengers may decide to make a test after arrival, before the Border Guard checkpoint – in this case they will not be put under quarantine.

The cost of the test made in Poland at the airport is 200 PLN (apx. 40 GBP) paid by credit card only. It takes approximately 20 minutes for getting the test result.

If the traveler, before going to the general access zone, does not have the test results, is obliged to provide the Border Guard officer with all the data necessary for the compulsory quarantine - the place of residence or the place where the quarantine will be held, and a contact telephone number. There is also a possibility to take a test in the luggage reclaim hall. In such case, the quarantine should be lifted within 2 hours after making the test.

People who have received a full dose of vaccinations accepted by the EU, as well as those who overcame the virus within last 6 months (and have a medical certificate in Polish or English) are exempted from quarantine.

ARRIVALS FROM OUTSIDE SCHENGEN

Persons arriving at Warsaw Chopin Airport non-Schengen during border control will be put under obligatory quarantine. Passengers, whose final destination is Poland, are obliged to provide the Border Guard officer with all information for quarantine control - place of residence or place of stay and a contact telephone number.

The quarantine can only be shortened by a negative COVID-19 test result made upon arrival in Poland and sent to the sanitary inspection's IT system within 48 hours. In testing points located at the Warsaw airport it is usually done within 2 hours after making a test.

The cost of the test made in Poland at the airport is 200 PLN (apx. 40 GBP) paid by credit card only. It takes approximately 20 minutes for getting the test result.

People who have received a full dose of vaccinations accepted by the EU, as well as those who overcame the virus within last 6 months (and have a medical certificate) are exempted from quarantine.

DOUBLE ROOMS AND RANDOM COVID-19 TESTS

The Organizer has the right to carry out random COVID tests every day before or after competition. If the test result is positive (two times), the person will not be able to take part in the competition and will have to go to the mandatory quarantine in the single room in the special dedicated Hotel. **If this person was accommodated in a double room**, the roommate, regardless of his test result, will also have to go to the mandatory quarantine in the single room in the special dedicated Hotel and will not be able to participate in the competition. Any additional costs associated with the quarantine must be covered by the national federations.

ACCOMODATION & COMPETITIONS

For safety reasons all of participants will be accommodated by the Organizer in the same Hotel. All meals will be served by the Hotel directly in rooms or in specially dedicated for our group venues, in accordance with the sanitary regime and applicable regulations. In accordance with the restrictions and regulations in force today (these regulations may change in July), men's and women's competitions will be played in separate venues. The LOC recommends that only the athletes in competition and their coaches be present in the venue. In order to ensure the safety of all participants, people from outside the Hotel will not be allowed to stay in the venue.

COMPETITION RULES

According to the FIE and IWFC rules

REFEREES

Each National Federation entering teams to the competition must provide one referee. In case, the delegation does not provide referee the delegation has to pay 1000 GBP penalty fee.

ENTRIES & REGISTRATION

Registration of the whole team (accreditations, accommodation, all travel details etc.) has to be done by mail office@szablakilinskiego.pl by sending official entry form (attached excel file)

In addition, all athletes and referees have to be registered via the Ophardt system:

Registration via Ophardt system is obligatory.

The data from Entry Forms and Ophardt system must be consistent and current. It is responsibility of national federations to inform LOC about any changes and keep all data up-to-date.

**The registration deadline (entry forms sent via mail and Ophardt system) is:
26th May 2021.**

Only in exceptional situations registration after 26th May 2021 may be considered by LOC and IWAS but 20% penalty fee would be added to the regular fee.

Each package includes: IWAS capitation fee, World Championships entry fee, airport pickup (only from WAW Chopin Airport), internal transport. All packages starts from the dinner on the day of arrival and continues (with all meals) until breakfast on the day of departure.

Because of COVID-19 situation and potential risk of mandatory quarantine LOC recommends single rooms.

All members of attending delegations should insure themselves in case of accidents, injuries or illness. The organizer will not accept any responsibility or financial loss or any other responsibility incurred by any of the participants.
